## Specific entry requirements

Passed results of at least 55 higher education credits from The Opometry programme's semester 1 and 2 and at least 45 higher education credits from semester 3 and 4.

#### **Objectives**

After the course, the student should be able to:

- make economic calculations related to optometric business activities.
- show knowledge of laws and rules that regulate the commercial part of optometric business.

#### **Content**

Course code: 10P030

The course is given as a distance education via the platform PingPong. The students work with exercises and laboratory sessions and written assignments at distance.

The Economics part contains: Economic concepts and relationship, Marketing, and Funding. The Law part contains: Product liability, laws related to buying and selling, marketing rules and regulations and Labour legislation.

### **Teaching methods**

The courses include study material, exercises and laboratory sessions via PingPong.

#### **Examination**
