Evaluation criteria: KISS applications

Individual applications are prioritized based on the overall assessment of study results, the motivation letter, and other merits. The minimum score is zero (0). The maximum score is five (5). Half (0.5) and quarter (0.25) points are given. A maximum of 43 placements can be offered per application year. There is no reserve list. Applications that are incomplete, illegible, or submitted after the deadline are not considered.

Study Results (0-2.5)

- Based on passed courses within the current program;
- when the courses were passed;
- and grades received.

Application Content and Motivation Letter (0-2.5)

- Based on the quality of the motivation letter;
- other commitments, e.g. participation in activities related to research, KI promotion, student associations, or relevant worklife experience;
- naming a principal investigator that has accepted to supervise the applicant;
- the applicant being early during their studies at KI.
