# Infectious Disease Control and Prevention and Public Health Emergency Responses

## Purpose and goal

The aim of the course is to give a broad and updated overview of the field of infectious disease control and prevention as well as public health emergency responses, from the Swedish health systems perspective.

## Content

The course includes aspects on the infectious disease situation in Sweden, control, prevention and impact on public health, outbreak management, early warning, crisis evaluation and the Swedish system in public health management.

The Swedish situation will be discussed from several perspectives; International, European and Swedish. Experiences will be shared and practical aspects as well as more theoretical foundations for the current practices will be explored. Lecturers and study visits will include besides a range of experts from the Karolinska Institutet and Swedish health care, experts from agencies such as the Public Health Agency of Sweden, the Swedish Civil Contingencies Agency, as well as European Centre for Disease Prevention and Control and other experts.

#### Content (Cont.) The course includes:

- Swedish system in organizing psychology intervention after disasters, how is it carried out and which organizations are involved etc.

- When there is an outbreak, how Swedish government deals with the media, how to control fear and spread the correct message

- Respiratory contagious disease outbreak: which kind of quarantine system is in place in Sweden, hospital isolation management
